Vice President Doug Leonard conducted the meeting.

Kelsee Miller reported on behalf of the Scholarship Committee. The committee met on January 22, 2007 to select scholarship recipients. Lenee Chamberlain was selected to receive the Outstanding Student Scholarship and Jennifer Garcia was chosen for the Harold Boedeker Scholarship. Kelsee recently sent information on the Hathaway Scholarship to the committee for their review as they revise the criteria for the Outstanding Student Scholarship. Charlotte Babcock announced that Jennifer Paad would again receive the Babcock Scholarship.

Doug reported that the Membership and Honors Committee met and dealt with several items. The list of past nominees for the Distinguished Alumni will be culled and given to Paul by March 1. The committee will submit the final nominees to the board at the April 28 meeting. The committee also reviewed a policy for recognizing board members for their service which will be brought forward at the April meeting. The committee discussed the process to select a replacement for Mike Porter. Paul will contact those who have submitted letters of interest to check on their current status. **The committee will meet again on April 18 at noon. Larry, Doug, Bill and Gigi will report on their review of the bylaws at the spring meeting.**
