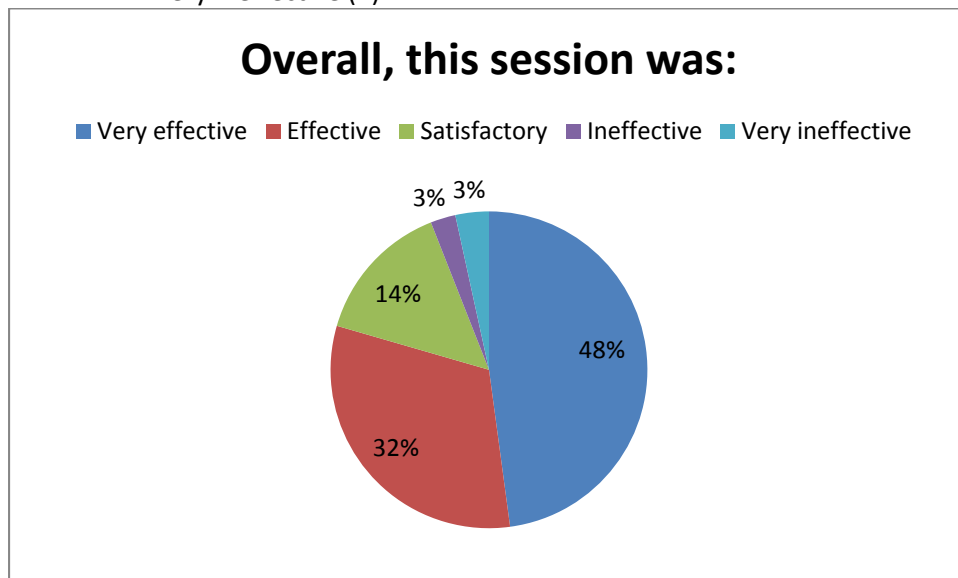

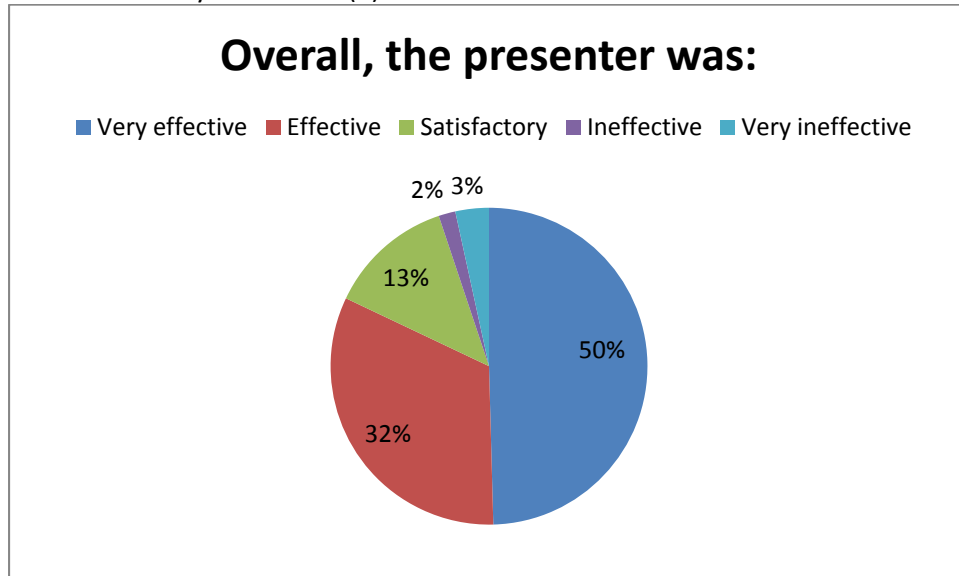
Center for Excellence Informational Sessions July – December 2010

- The Center for Excellence served just over 248 employees during July – December 2010 by offering over 88 informational sessions.
 - Attendance for all 88 sessions totaled to 655 employees.
 - 67 different topics were offered including, but not limited to, distance education, informational technology, teaching tips, nutritional information, staff development, assessment, and campus resources. Most of these sessions were evaluated by participants. The results of those evaluations are below:

- 117 responses were received on Survey Monkey from 88 Center for Excellence sessions
