4. Click on "Students"
5. Click on "Register for sections."
6. Click on "Express Registration."
7. Enter the course "synonym" in the first column and click submit at the bottom of the page.
8. "Search and Register for Sections" is available if you don't know what class you are looking for.
9. You may drop and add classes from WebAdvisor up until the time classes start.
10. Print your schedule by clicking the printer icon on the toolbar.

Key:

Syn: Synonym, a four- or five- digit number that is unique to a particular course and section.

Level: Level is sometimes called the "Course number." Four digits. Some have an "L" at the end, which indicates that it is a lab section.

Cr.: Credits you'll earn by taking the class. Lab sections show zero credits, because the credits are listed with the lecture section.

Del: Delivery of course. LEC (Lecture), LAB (Laboratory), LAL (Lecture and Lab), NET (Internet-based course), CVT (Compressed Video), TV (Telecourse), IND (Independent Study), INN (Internship), PRA (Practicum), WRK (Cooperative Work Experience), PRB (Problem Solving), WKS (Workshop), STU (Studio), TRV (Travel), LES (Lesson).

What is distance learning?

Distance learning refers to courses that are offered outside of a traditional classroom using a variety of technologies for delivery. Distance learning courses provide more flexible scheduling options and the opportunity to participate from convenient locations. There are generally no regularly scheduled on-campus meetings but there are still deadlines and communication requirements with the instructor and other students.

Is distance learning right for me?

Distance learning courses require students to be disciplined in their work and study habits. Instructors provide opportunities for interaction and students are responsible for participating in course activities. Success in any course is determined by a multitude of factors. Please make sure you take the Student Readiness Self-Assessment survey before registering for a distance learning course. This survey may help you decide whether a distance learning class is right for you.

Are CC distance learning courses self-paced?

Most distance learning courses have scheduled dates for exams, papers, participating in discussions or other course exercises. While some may have flexible assignment due dates, distance learning courses follow the same academic calendar as classroom courses.

Distance learning course delivery modes

Internet or online delivery; courses (usually identified as N1 N2, etc.) offered online or over the internet.

Telecourses delivery, courses (usually identified as T1, T2, etc.) offered through television broadcast over the Public Broadcasting System (PBS) or by video tape or rental. All telecourses also have an Internet component.

Compressed video delivery, courses (usually identified as C1, C2, etc.) are offered to remote sites through live video classrooms presentation over the Wyoming Equality Network (WEN).

Hybrid delivery, courses (usually identified as H1, H2, D1, D2, etc.) are offered through a variety of methods including internet and on-campus lab participation.

Please visit www.caspercollege.edu/distance to learn more about our programs and services. The majority of distance learning classes are internet/online courses. Presently, Casper College uses two online Course Management Systems, WebCT and Moodle.

Can I start and finish my distance learning course at any time?

Distance learning courses are offered during the fall, spring, and summer semesters with the same session lengths (16-wk, 16-wk, 8-wk, etc.) as on-campus courses. Distance learning courses conform to the standard College instructional calendar. Students may complete a course early with instructor approval. However, final performance grades are issued at the close of the semester. For the most part, distance learning courses are not scheduled with flex entry/flex exit options.

Web Enhanced Classes – Any course offered at Casper College may be “web enhanced,” A web enhanced class uses the Internet as an additional resource to supplement the lecture and/or lab. On campus computers are available to all students to access the web resources of their classes.

Prerequisites: Enrollment in some Casper College classes is restricted to students who have met specific requirements of prior coursework or placement exams. Courses listed in this schedule marked with an asterisk () have designated prerequisites. See the current Casper College catalog for further details and course descriptions.*
