Campus Dining Meal Plans

In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the 2008-2009 academic year. If you need to purchase a meal plan, or if you would like to make a change to the plan you have already selected, simply contact the Accounting and Financial Management Office located in the Administration Building.

Having trouble selecting a meal plan? Try considering your daily routine... Do you eat three meals a day? Will your class schedule, studying, extracurricular activities and social events interfere with dining? Will you miss dinner due to employment or evening classes? Anticipating to answers to these and similar questions will help you to select a meal plan that best fits your lifestyle.

If you live in the Residence Halls you must purchase one of the five meal plans

- 20 meals/week \$1055 per semester
- 15 meals/week \$1025 per semester
- 10 meals/week \$995 per semester
- 15 meals/week \$1055 per semester

plus 60 Bonus Bucks per semester

- 10 meals/week \$1025 per semester
- plus 80 Bonus Bucks per semester*

These rates do not include housing.

In addition to these meal plans we also have T-Bucks available for everyone to add on to your ID. Buy in at \$200, you get \$225. Buy in at \$100 you get \$110. Buy in at \$50 you get \$52.

Meal Cards

Selection of a Campus Dining Services Meal Plan entitles you to eat in the Robert Commons Cafeteria. Selection of a Campus Dining Services Meal Plan with Bonus Bucks opens up a whole new array of dining choices. You will be able to use your bonus bucks to by meals in the Ben Roberts Cafeteria for friends and guests. You will also be able to use Bonus Bucks at our T-Bird on the Go coffee cart, located in the Physical Science Building, and the Doornbos Student Lounge, located in the Administration Building.

Lost Your Meal Card?

Your student ID card is your ticket to eat! Do not lose this, have it with you at every meal. If you do lose it you can get a new one in the Student Services Office in the Administration Building for five dollars.

Seconds Anyone?

You never have to be too shy to ask for seconds with our Campus Dining Program. Our generous policy allows for a second helping of many menu favorites. All you have to do is ask! Please note, however, there are some exceptions to our Seconds Policy including Ethnic Dinners, Steak Nights, and Chicken Wings.
