Dining Hall

The campus dining hall is located in the Roberts Commons Building and offers a variety of all-you-care-to-eat options. Some of your choices include:

Classics: traditional comfort foods including casseroles and freshly Steamed or Sautéed Vegetables just like you're used to from home

Pizza-rette: freshly made pizzas every day with your favorite toppings such as Five Cheeses and Grilled Vegetables

Flash in the Pan: where our chefs prepare some of your favorites including Raviolis with Marinara, Vegetable Stir Fry and Penne Pasta ala Pesto

Gifts from the Garden: our Salad Bar is abundant with fresh local Produce, Legumes, Grains, Fruits and homemade "composed" salads such as Pasta Salad and Potato Salad

Meal Plans

In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the 2010-2011 academic year. You may choose whichever plan best meets your dining needs. The dining plans allow students access to the Roberts Commons Dining Hall. Meal plans that include Flex Dollars can be used at all on-campus dining locations. All meal plans may be used only by the cardholder.

Platinum

\$1150/semester - 19 meals every week - Allows you access to all 19 meals available at Roberts Commons Dining Hall every week.

Platinum Flex

\$1150/semester - 15 meals every week plus \$60 - Allows you access to 15 of the 19 meals available at Roberts Commons Dining Hall, \$60 that can be used at the coffee shops in the Administration and Physical Science Buildings.

Gold

\$990/semester - 10 meals every week - Allows you access to 10 of the 19 meals available at Roberts Commons Dining Hall every week.

Gold Flex

\$1050/semester - 10 meals every week plus \$80 - Allows you access to 10 of the 19 meals available at Roberts Commons Dining Hall, \$80 that can be used at the coffee shops in the Administration and Physical Science Buildings.

Commuter / Faculty Pass

\$500/semester - 60 meals that can be used any day during any regularly offered meal at Roberts Commons Dining Hall.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I need to purchase a meal plan?

A: Yes! It's a great value and it is Casper College's policy that all designated Campus Residents purchase a meal plan each semester.

Q: What are Flex Dollars?

A: Flex Dollars are cash values included in some meal plans. They work like a pre-paid debit card with funds kept on your student ID card. Flex Dollars may be used at any on-campus dining location.

Q: Do Flex Dollars carry over from quarter to quarter?

A: They are a part of your meal plan for that quarter and should be used during that time. They are not carried over from quarter to quarter.

Q: Do missed meals carry over from week to week?

A: Meals should be used during the current week and do not carry over from week to week.

Q: Can I change my meal plan if it does not fit my needs?

A: Yes! Changing to a bigger or smaller meal plan can be done during the first ten days of the school quarter. Changing to a larger plan is possible at any time during the quarter.

Q: If I'm not a Resident Hall student, where do I buy my meal plan?

A: If you live off-campus, you can purchase meal plans at the Campus Business office located on the main floor of the Administration Building. Cash and credit cards are accepted as payment.

Q: What if I want to add to my Flex dollars?

Flex dollars are a smart and easy way to make purchases. The program works like a pre-paid debit card and balances carry over from year to year. For more information on this great deal, call us at (307) 268-2395.
