**Duties include:**

Teach applied saxophone and clarinet and other woodwind instruments as qualified. Teach related subjects: jazz improvisation class; direct jazz ensemble, jazz combo, and select woodwind ensembles; administer the annual Kinser Jazz Festival. Possible assignments in other areas of music, depending upon qualifications and interests, may include either Music History survey courses or the Introduction to Music Education course.

Assist in recruitment, engage in creative, scholarly activities and service appropriate for a community college faculty member, maintain office hours, accurate records, advise students, attend department meetings, and serve on campus committees. Perform other duties as listed in the Faculty Job Description or as requested by the Administration.

- College teaching experience highly desirable
- Expertise in organizing a major jazz festival required
