# Theatre History, Literature Faculty Opening

Casper College is seeking applications for a full-time faculty position in Theatre.

Casper College offers three N.A.S.T.-accredited degrees: Associate of Arts in Acting, Technical Theatre, and Musical Theatre Performance. Also, the Associate of Arts in Dance is offered. Six full-time, one part-time faculty, and two staff serve about 60 majors. In its main season, the Department of Theatre and Dance produces three plays, one musical, and a dance production. In addition, a musical is produced during the summer term.

The Department of Theatre and Dance is housed in the Gertrude Krampert Theatre Complex, consisting of the McMurry Mainstage (400-seat thrust); a Black Box (52' x 50' theatre with flexible seating to 180); Scifers Dance Theatre (seating 139); Ken Ury Little Theatre (seating 44); Fully equipped scenic and costume shops.

**Responsibilities include:**

- Teach Introduction to Theatre, Backgrounds to Dramatic Literature I and II
- Direct one or two productions per academic year
- Teach in other areas of interest depending upon qualifications, interest, and program need
- Directing a musical production in the summer term is optional
- Assist in recruitment; engage in creative, scholarly activities and service appropriate for a community college faculty member; advise students; maintain office hours; keep accurate records; attend department and school meetings; and serve on campus committees. Perform other duties as listed in the Faculty Job Description or as requested by the administration.

**Qualifications**

Masters Degree in Theatre, minimum. M.F.A. or Ph.D. desired. Experience in directing required. College teaching experience desired.
