Selection Process

Receipt of your application will be acknowledged. For most positions, soon after closing date, application materials are reviewed, interviews conducted, and selections made by a committee. Applicants may call or e-mail the Human Resources Office to inquire regarding the status of the selection process.

World Languages - German Faculty Opening

Casper College is seeking applicants for a fulltime faculty position to teach German. In addition to teaching college courses, this position will assist the department in implementing articulation agreements with the local high schools.

Duties include:

Teach at least two college classes in German each semester. Potential to team teach in high school language classes; engage in curriculum comparisons; explore and facilitate agreements between the high schools and the College's World Languages Department; manage and expand use of the College's Language Laboratory.

Engage in departmental duties; maintain reasonable office hours, attend faculty, department and school meetings; serve on department and college-wide committees as assigned by the dean.

Keep accurate records; evaluate student performance; and contribute to the assessment of course, program-specific, and college-wide outcomes and on-going curriculum development. Assist with academic advising, participate in faculty development and student recruitment. Perform other duties as listed in the Faculty Job Description or as requested by the administration.

Qualifications

- Requires Master's degree in German plus graduate studies in a second language, preferably Spanish or French
- Requires ability to speak and write German at the advanced or superior level
- Successful teaching experience desirable

- Current resume / curriculum vitae indicating cumulative years of full-time college teaching or cumulative credit hours for part time teaching
- List three references showing relationship and complete contact information
