



CNA Information FALL 2010

The CNA courses at Casper College are in great demand and the courses fill up rapidly.

In order to ensure enrollment for the course you want, it is essential that you follow these instructions:

MEET THE REQUIRED PRE-REQUISITES---YOU WILL NOT BE REGISTERED WITHOUT THE PROOF OF CPR and RESULTS OF THE TB SKIN TEST!!

A. Proof of CPR (only 1 of the following are accepted-no exceptions will be granted)

- Current American Heart Association BLS for Health Care Providers CPR (HLTK 0950 on campus) **OR**
- Current American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer.
- Either card must be current throughout the entire class period.
- **Bring the original card plus a copy.**

B. Current PPD (TB skin test)

- Administered within one year and valid through end of the CNA course.
- **Bring a copy of this verification.**

C. Meet with your advisor or N. Arana to register once you have proof of the correct CPR and results of the TB skin test.

D. Take the form to Admissions Office, AD 132 to register for class. The cost of in-state tuition is \$308* (please check with Admissions for WUE or Out-of-state tuition).

E. Purchase textbook and workbook from the bookstore in Strausner Student Center Bldg

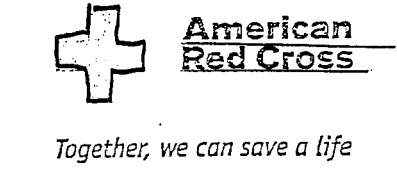
