

## ESTIMATED EXPENSES – 12/11

Prospective students should refer to the current Casper College catalog for tuition and fee rates. Please note ATI fees are **non-refundable**. In addition to tuition and fees and required laboratory supplies, the following expenses are estimated for the **first semester** of the nursing program:

◆	Books	\$ 1,000
◆	Supplies	\$ 50
◆	Uniforms and lab coat	\$ 200
◆	Lab kit / Lab and ATI fees	\$ 300
◆	Watch with digital or sweep second hand	\$ 30
◆	Stethoscope	\$ 20
◆	Eye protection	\$ 12
◆	Bandage scissors	\$ 7
◆	Penlight	\$ 5
◆	Nursing Program badge	\$ 2
◆	Sharpie®	\$ 2
◆	Chicken pox titer	\$ 5
◆	Chicken pox vaccine x2 (available at Public Health Department)	\$ 100 each if negative titer
◆	Hepatitis Titer	\$ 50
◆	Hepatitis immunization series	\$ 90
◆	MMR Titer	\$ 15
◆	MMR Vaccine	\$ 50
◆	Health insurance-if not covered by other policy	\$ 750 annually

Casper College provides at no expense to students, liability (malpractice) insurance while nursing students are engaged in their clinical laboratory activities. As is stated in the catalog, students are responsible for their own transportation and its related expense.

### Expenses for the **second** semester include:

◆	Cap and gown fee	\$15
◆	Application for nursing license fee + background check	\$190
◆	NCLEX-RN exam	\$200
◆	Pinning ceremony-depends on class decisions	?????
