

Jack Rosenthal Collection

Donated in multiple donations by the Rosenthal Family, This collection contains numerous items relative to the history of Wyoming.

Series I contain the Wyoming State Quarter information when Jack Rosenthal was chair of the committee to design and create a Wyoming state quarter.

Series II contains information on the Wyoming Stamp Collection. Jack Rosenthal was chairman of the US postal citizen's advisory committee and designed the Oregon Trail commemorative stamp.

Series III contains miscellaneous information on F. E. Hayden and G. K. Warren as well as William Cody. Most of this information are copies of records elsewhere or printed information from the Internet. Biographical information on Jack Rosenthal is also included in this series.

Series IV contains the Wyoming Postal Collection. This collection is PHOTOCOPIES of Jack Rosenthal's Wyoming postal cover collection that was dispersed at auction. These are photocopies of that original collection before it was dismantled.
