STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY:

Students become liable for charges incurred upon registering for courses. It is each student's responsibility to know the correct tuition and fees owed and for timely payment of those charges. By registering for courses, the student agrees to the policies of Casper College and the terms and conditions connected with their enrollment.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS:

- Statements are mailed before the beginning of a new semester and approximately monthly thereafter.
- Current students may view their statements online on myCCinfo, accessible at www.caspercollege.edu.
- Students should maintain a correct address with Enrollment Services, Gateway Building, third floor.
- If no statement is received, contact Accounting & Financial Management office to request a statement.

For students registered in more than 12 credits, there will be an additional \$34 charge per credit hour.

Course fees are in addition to tuition and fees and are indicated with the course listing. Full tuition and fees are charged for an **audited** course.

HOW TO PAY:

Payments may be made:

- **In person** at the Financial Management/Cashier Office, Gateway Building, third floor, **cash and check only**
 - **Online** at www.caspercollege.edu, log into myCCinfo, Student Finance or access directly at caspercollege.afford.com
- Payments can be made by ACH or credit or debit card. Payment by

credit card may be subject to additional fees.

• **Utilize a payment plan**, see Payment Plan information below

• **Third party authorization**, by employer, VA benefits, government organization (DVR, WIA, BOCES), or a prepaid tuition program. Authorizations and completed paperwork must be received prior to payment deadline. Company authorizations must be on company letterhead and signed by an authorized company representative.

Student is ultimately responsible for payment of account if any of these default.

PAYING WITH FINANCIAL AID:

- Verify that expected aid has been credited to your account prior to the payment deadline.
- Some scholarships and student loans require the student's endorsement before the award can be credited to the student's account.
- If there is a delay in receipt of financial aid, utilize the payment plan to cover payment of the account by the deadline.
- If financial aid is issued by another institution, Casper College tuition and fees will NOT be deducted from that financial aid.

PAYMENT PLAN:

Casper College offers a monthly or bimonthly payment plan to allow you to pay your educational expenses in smaller, more manageable monthly/bimonthly installments. Utilize the payment plan if payment cannot be made in full by the payment deadline, when there is a delay in processing financial aid or if the student is in the process of making changes or seeking adjustment to their account when payment is due.

• Payment plan forms are available online at caspercollege.afford.com All payment plans are required to be paid in full by July 15, 2019.

PAYMENT DUE DATES:

Payment due dates are based on the registration, not the starting date of a course.

Casper College tuition and fees are due by the payment deadline.

EXTENSION/LATE PAYMENT FEES:

An automatic extension fee is assessed when the student's account balance is not paid in full or a payment plan is not in place by the stated due date. A semester late payment fee is charged to any account with a balance as of the end of the semester. A student may submit a petition to waive extension/late fees to the Financial Management Office.

RETURNED CHECKS:

- All returned checks will be assessed a return check fee.
- If the check was for payment on account, the payment is considered not to have been made and extension fee or late payment fee will also be charged.

REFUND POLICY FOR DROPPING A COURSE OR WITHDRAWING FROM COLLEGE:

For exception to the refund policy for the semester, a student may submit a petition to Enrollment Services,

Gateway Building, third floor by October 1, 2019.

For Full Semester Courses:

- Drop by June 7, 2019 and 100% of tuition and fees will be credited and you owe nothing.
- Drop by June 14, 2019 and 50% of tuition only will be credited to you and you will owe 50% of tuition and all per credit fees.
- Drop after June 14, 2019 and you will owe all tuition, per credit fees, and course fee charges.

For Less than Full Semester courses:

The above “drop by” dates **DO NOT** apply to courses that meet for less than a full semester. The length of each refund period is proportional to the length of the less than full semester course.

CHARGING BOOKS AT THE CAMPUS BOOKSTORE:

If you would to use your excess financial aid to purchase books and/or supplies as our campus bookstore, you can do so from May 20 – June 7, 2019. This only applies to students who are expecting a financial aid refund.

DROPPING COURSES AND COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL FROM CASPER COLLEGE:

- Dropping courses or withdrawing from college may affect current and future financial aid awards.
- Your eligibility to retain insurance coverage can also be affected.
- Additional charges may result from schedule changes or a balance due may remain after a drop or complete withdrawal. Contact the Financial Management Office to verify the effects of a schedule change, course dropped, or complete withdrawal.
- A complete withdrawal **CANNOT** be done through myCCinfo. Student can do a complete withdrawal online at www.caspercollege.edu, A-Z index, Withdrawal Request Form. Contact Enrollment Services 307-268-2323 for questions.
- Non Attendance does not constitute withdrawal from courses. A student

is responsible for charges incurred to date of formal withdrawal. Notify Enrollment Services if you are not going to attend, 307-268-2323.

FAILURE TO PROPERLY REGISTER:

A student who attends class without being properly registered in that course and subsequently wishes to receive credit for that course, will be required to pay, with collected funds, the tuition and fees associated with the course plus all of that semester’s extension and late fees prior to the student’s enrollment in the course.

PAST DUE ACCOUNTS

- A financial hold is placed on an account whenever a payment is past due or when the account has an outstanding balance, regardless of payment arrangements, prior to early registration.
- The financial hold will prevent new registrations and the issuance of academic transcripts.
- To release a financial hold, the debt must be paid in full. Payment with collected funds will release the hold upon payment. There is a two week wait from the date of deposit when payment is by personal check.
- New registrations will be cancelled for nonpayment of a prior semester debt.
- An account that has not met payment requirements will be referred for collection.

CONSEQUENCES OF AN ACCOUNT IN FULL COLLECTION

- There will be no adjustment to or petition consideration given to an outstanding balance.
- Account will be assessed collection costs, court costs and attorney’s fees incurred as a result of collection efforts. The default will be reported to credit reporting agencies.
- Future enrollment will require prepayment of tuition and fees with collected funds prior to registration. Student will not be permitted to utilize the payment plan.

*An asterisk in the left column indicates that the course has a **prerequisite**. See current college catalog (catalog.caspercollege.edu) for more information about requirements to enroll in the course.

Syn: Synonym-This is a 5-digit number is assigned to a course; entering synonyms is an easy way to register on [MyCInfo](#).

Level: Department. This is the department code for a course. Example: ACCT stands for accounting. Course numbers 1000 and above are considered college level courses.

Section Numbers. Courses with multiple sections are assigned section numbers. Section numbers that start with an "N" indicate the class is offered **online**. Section numbers that start with an "H" indicate hybrid classes where part of the class is offered **online and** part of the class is offered **face to face**. Section numbers that start with an "R" indicate **self-paced** class that meets **face to face**. "D" indicate the class is offered **online** at a **specific time and day**.

Cr.: Credits you'll earn by taking the class. Lab sections show zero credits, because the credits are listed with the lecture section. This is the number of credits a class is assigned; some classes are only worth partial credit, indicated by .5 or .33.

Del: Delivery of course. Indicates the delivery format for the class. Example: lecture, lab, practicum, Internet-based, independent study, etc. LEC (lecture), LAB (laboratory), LAL (Lecture and Lab), NET (Internet-based course), FLX (Flex Lab), IND (Independent Study), INN (Internship), PRA (Practicum), WRK (Cooperative Work Experience), WKS (Workshop), STU (Studio), TRV (Travel), LES (Lesson).

Days: The days of the week the class meets. MWF means the class meets every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. TR indicates the class meets every Tuesday and Thursday. S designates Saturday and SU designates Sunday.
