

## Housing Accommodations Statement

Casper College is committed to compliance with the Section 504 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act and its amendments when assisting our students in their learning and living environments.

The Office of Disability Services will assist students in the evaluation of appropriate services in the classroom as well as campus housing.

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Students will not be charged any additional fees for services provided

Residence Hall room rates 2019-2020:

Residence Hall, Double Occupancy: \$1,830/semester \$3,660/academic year  
Residency Hall Single Occupancy: \$2,775/semester \$5,550/academic year  
Wheeler Terrace, (double occupancy, private bathroom): 2,704/semester \$5,408/academic year  
Civic apartments: \$650/month (12 month contract)  
Thorson Apartments \$650/month (12 month contract)
