Students will not be charged any additional fees for services provided, nor will additional fees be charged for approved accommodations.

Casper College recognizes the importance of service and emotional support animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Fair Housing Act. Students with service and support animals must work with Disability Support Services to obtain approval for having their animal in residence as an accommodation. This approval must be obtained prior to the animal moving into campus housing.

**Additional Safety and/or Convenience Features of the Residence Hall Complex:**

- 12 Handicapped Accessible rooms with ADA approved showers and vanities
- 8 Handicapped parking spaces in the main parking lot
- Key fob entry to exterior doors with power push-button openers
- Security cameras in all hallways, stairwells, and entryways
- Centrally located elevator
- 4 Resident Assistants (RAs) per floor
- On-site campus security staff

If a student has requested a location other than the Residence Hall Complex that does not meet their accommodative needs, every attempt will be made to find an equitable solution.
