Locate the unofficial transcript .pdf file you saved on your computer, click on the file, and click Open. This will upload your transcript to MyCCs. If you have more than one transcript to upload, such as a transcript from another college, you may do so in one of the other two sections listed.

New/Incoming Students:

Make sure to communicate with your high school or other institution and ask them to forward your transcript to Casper College.

**Official transcripts from colleges and universities are not required for MyCCs. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable, and you may upload on your own if you have a copy.

Once you've requested your transcripts be sent to Casper College, please email <u>ccscholarships@caspercollege.edu</u> containing your student ID, first and last name, asking the Scholarship office to upload your transcript to MyCCs. Be sure to include the name of the school from which your transcripts have been sent.
