



Transfer Agreement
Between
University of Montana
and
Casper College



This Transfer Agreement, to be effective November 1, 2019, is established to provide the opportunity for graduates of the Athletic Training Program at Casper College to be eligible for admission to the University of Montana's Master's in Athletic Training Program.

Objectives of the Agreement


- 1) To provide diploma graduates from Casper College who satisfy the criteria identified by University of Montana and described in this agreement, the opportunity to obtain admission to the University of Montana.
- 2) To attract qualified students from Casper College and University of Montana.
- 3) To provide specific program information and course information to Casper College Degree graduates who wish to pursue an entry level Master's in Athletic Training.
- 4) To establish the processes to encourage, review and expand, if appropriate, the Transfer Agreement between Casper College and University of Montana.

Terms of the Agreement

- 1) In a manner consistent with its admission requirements, policies and procedures, University of Montana will grant admission to Casper College students with 60 credit hours who have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (on the four-point grading system) in the above mentioned degree programs as described on pages Casper College course catalog.
- 2) Both Casper College and University of Montana will cooperate in promoting the University of Montana Athletic Training Master's program to qualified Casper College graduates and agree to provide information and assistance to prospective transfer students.
- 3) The initial term of this Agreement shall be for one (1) year commencing on the effective date of this Agreement and shall thereafter be automatically renewed for successive one (1) year terms unless either party provides the other party with written notice of termination.
- 4) Termination of this Transfer Agreement shall only be undertaken by either party with written notice of at least one calendar year (12 months). In the event of termination of this Transfer Agreement, all students enrolled in the Casper College Associate's Degree program at the date of such termination shall be entitled to apply for admission to the applicable University of Montana (as outlined above) upon graduation so as to ensure the fulfillment of the reasonable expectations of such students.
- 5) Either institution must inform the other if substantive changes in curriculum (greater than 15%) are to be implemented.
- 6) Both Casper College and University of Montana will designate a Program Representative in their respective institutions to facilitate coordination of this Transfer Agreement.


