This Transfer Agreement, to be effective ~~7/3/23~~ is established to allow graduates of the Visual Arts program at Casper College (CC) to be eligible for transfer to the University of North Dakota's (UND) Visual Arts program.

Objectives of the Agreement

1) To provide diploma graduates from CC's Visual Arts program who satisfy the criteria required to transfer to the UND Visual Arts Program under the course work articulation terms provided by UND (attached).

Terms of the Agreement

1). UND agrees to accept students from CC who meet the criteria set by NDUS procedure 411.7 Transfer Applicant as published on UND's Admissions Website. 2). Both CC and UND will cooperate in promoting UND's Visual Arts B.A. to qualified Casper College Visual Arts program graduates and agree to provide information and assistance to prospective transfer students. 3). The initial term of this Agreement shall be for a (5) five-year term commencing on the effective date of this Agreement and ending in March 2030. Upon review by the visual art Faculty of UND and CC in March 2030, the agreement can be renewed for another five-year term. Termination of this Transfer Agreement shall only be undertaken by either party with a written notice of at least one calendar year (12 months). In the event of termination of this Transfer Agreement, all students enrolled in the CC Associate's Degree program at the date of such termination shall be entitled to apply for admission to the applicable UND program (as outlined above) upon graduation to ensure the fulfillment of the reasonable expectations of such students. 4). Either institution must inform the other if substantive changes in curriculum (greater than 15%) are to be implemented.



Transfer students will have satisfied UND's Essential Studies requirements if they have completed an Associate of Arts Degree (A.A.), an Associate of Science Degree (A.S.), or a four-year bachelor's degree (An Associate of Applied Science and Bachelor of Applied Science do not fulfill these requirements).

Students who do not meet one of these conditions will have their transfer credit evaluated for applicable Essential Studies transfer credit on an individual course-by-course basis.

Additional classes will be required to earn the B.F.A. degree; a minimum of 120 credits is required to graduate from UND.

A complete listing of program requirements can be found in the Academic Catalog at UND-public.courseleaf.com.

Transfer credit for courses other than those listed will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

Students can apply for admissions up to one year in advance of planning to transfer to UND. Review the transfer process online at UND.edu/admissions/transfer.

Transfer Pathways will be reviewed and updated every two years.
